## Why do we need more housing?

Targets are given by National Government, and under a revision to the current South Worcestershire Development Plan, Malvern Hills District Council are allocating housing across the district for the period up to 2041. The exact level of housing we are required to have will be decided shortly.

## Where should housing go?

The Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP) for Hallow will contribute to the process of site assessment and site selection. On the recommendation of the NDP Steering Group, Hallow Parish Council commissioned a leading consultancy, AECOM, to carry out an initial site assessment. This was funded by Locality grant and has not cost the Parish anything. The public events will show the process of this assessment and the results. In addition, Malvern Hills District Council have assessed sites, using additional planning criteria and additional information. This has enabled Hallow Parish Council to consider which are the most appropriate for future housing. Hallow Parish Council and the NDP group now invite villagers to attend one of the public information events so that these findings can be shared, and comment from villagers can be sought.

## Other important issues for Hallow

The public information events will also show:

- an overview of the Design Guidelines for future housing builds. These guidelines help to ensure that future building is sympathetic to Hallow.
- key policies for inclusion in the Neighbourhood Development Plan, including policies on the protection of key views, green spaces, and the protection of our built heritage.
